

1 CHMP5

CHMP5 belongs to the chromatin-modifying protein/charged multivesicular body protein (CHMP) family. These proteins are components of ESCRT-III (endosomal sorting complex required for transport III), a complex involved in degradation of surface receptor proteins and formation of endocytic multivesicular bodies (MVBs).

The gene is stronger expressed in bat than in human.

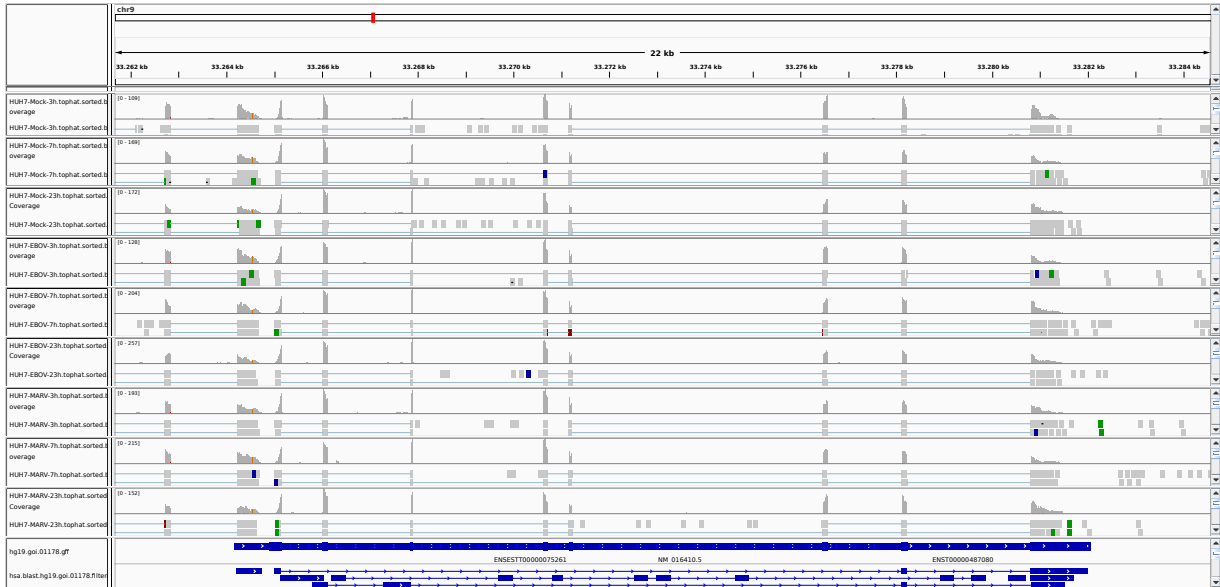


Figure 1: IGV Genome Browser screenshot of gene CHMP5.

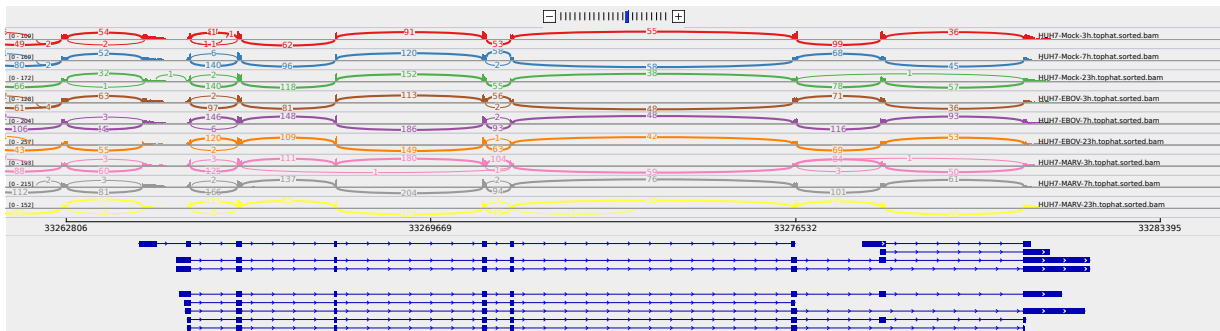


Figure 2: Sashimi plot of gene CHMP5.

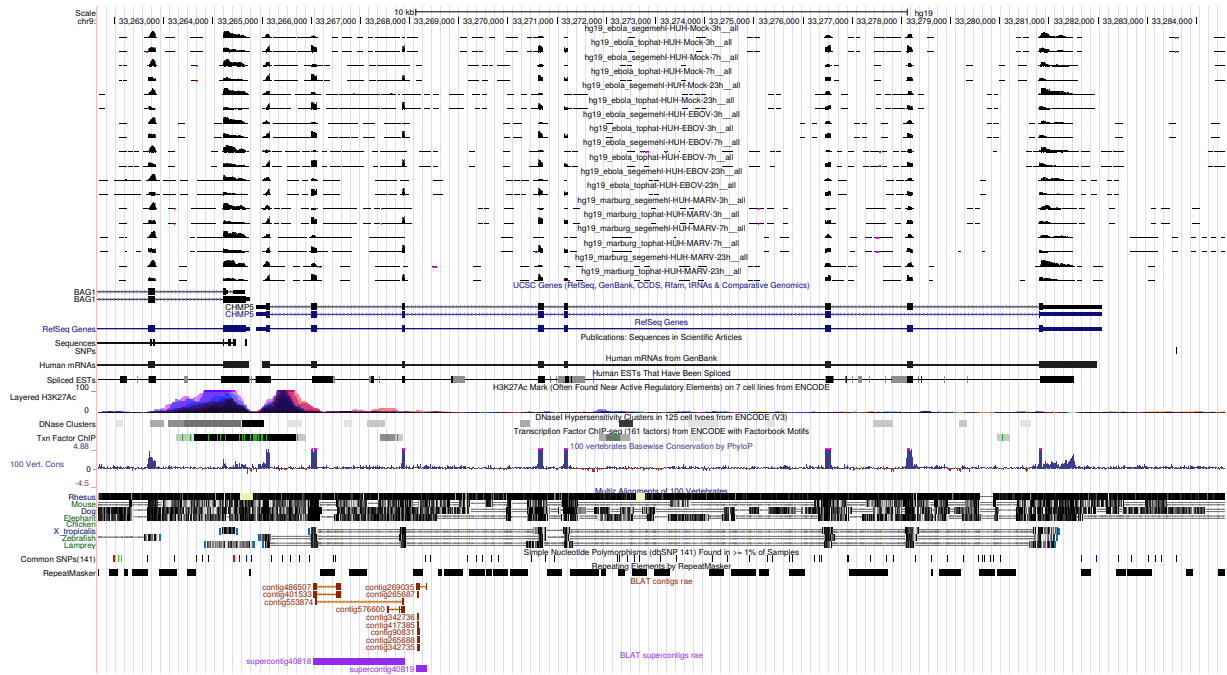


Figure 3: UCSC Genome Browser screenshot of gene CHMP5.
